
## **EQUALITY AND EQUITY**

We use our platforms to share First Nations events and products and to encourage non-Indigenous people to learn more about First Nations histories and cultures through engaging with First Nations content.

# UNITY

Through education in schools, organisations and the community, Reconciliation NSW supports the embedding of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander perspectives. Our Pathways to Reconciliation program works with local Elders and cultural educators to teach schools about First Nations cultures – giving them the tools to progress as leaders in reconciliation.

Beyond the school setting, our website offers a range of toolkits and factsheets to educate non-Indigenous Australia on our shared histories. We are strong supporters and advocates for a First Nations voice to parliament and use our position in the community to have important conversations about the Uluru Statement from the Heart.



## **HISTORICAL ACCEPTANCE**

Without acknowledgement and acceptance of the past, we cannot move forward as a unified nation. Reconciliation NSW amplifies the voices of Indigenous peoples when dealing with the trauma of historical wrongs. We seek to provide contextual information for non-Indigenous Australians on the social, political, and economic framework of this country.

Through our strategic programs and events, we work to create a state that has widespread understanding of the importance of reconciliation through self-determination.
