HARR acknowledges the Traditional Owners who are the spiritual custodians of this land and pays respects to the elders, to Aboriginal beliefs and to this land.

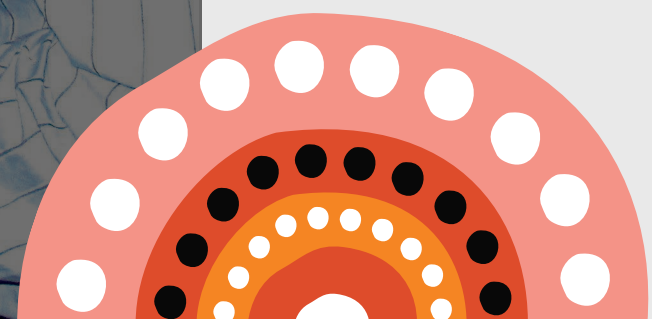

HARR is the local Reconciliation Group for Indigenous and non-Indigenous residents of the Hornsby area.

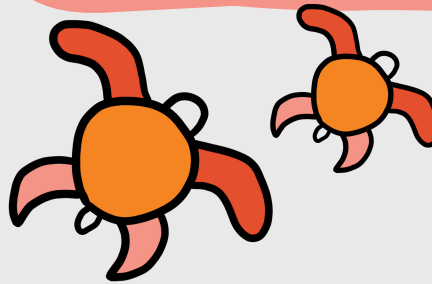

OUR OBJECTIVES

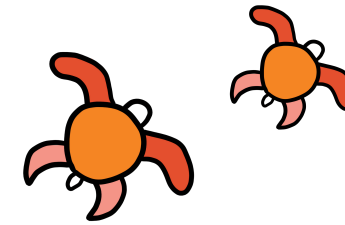
HARR OBJECTIVES ARE TO
